AWARDS

CANADA GAMES FLAG

At the end of each sport in the Canada Games, each province/territory is ranked according to a system outlined in the sport's technical package. Canada Games flag points are then awarded. Men and women are ranked separately when they compete separately.

When all sports are complete, the points for each contingent are added together. The province/territory having the highest flag point total is awarded the Canada Games flag.

AWARDS

CLAUDE HARDY AWARD

The Claude Hardy award is named after a long-serving chef de mission for Team Quebec. He died after the 1999 Games in Corner Brook, Newfoundland. The award was first presented in 2001, to Team Nova Scotia, and then again in 2003, at the Bathurst-Campbellton Winter Games.

The recipient is chosen through a vote by all provincial and territorial mission staff. It is presented to the mission staff that best exhibits leadership, co-operation, integrity and esprit de corps.

AWARDS

CENTENNIAL CUP

At the end of a Canada Games, the Centennial Cup is awarded to the province or territory that makes the greatest improvement from Summer Games to Summer Games or Winter Games to Winter Games. The improvement is measured in terms of flag points. It takes the effort of the entire team to win this award.

Team Nova Scotia has brought home the Centennial Cup three times:

2001 Summer Games in London, Ontario

1981 Summer Games in Thunder Bay, Ontario

1975 Winter Games in Lethbridge, Alberta

AWARDS

JACK PELECH AWARD

The Jack Pelech Award is presented to the provincial or territorial team whose athletes, coaches, managers and mission staff best combine competitive performance, good sportsmanship and a spirit of fair play, cooperation and friendship.

Jack Pelech was chair of the board of directors of the Canada Games Council from 1971 to 2001.

Nova Scotia shared the award with Newfoundland at the 1987 Canada Winter Games in Cape Breton, Nova Scotia.

AWARDS

ROLAND MICHENER AWARD

Roland Michener was Canada's governor general from 1967, the first year of the Canada Games, to 1974. The award in his name was created in 1992 and recognizes his contribution to sport and physical activity. It is presented to one male and one female athlete from each Games.

Winners of the Roland Michener Canada Games Award exemplify strong leadership skills on and off the playing field, and an ongoing commitment to scholastic and athletic excellence.

Hockey sensation Sidney Crosby was Nova Scotia's first winner of the award in 2004. He was a member of Team Nova Scotia at the 2003 Canada Winter Games in Bathurst-Campbellton, New Brunswick.

STATS AND FACTS

The 2009 edition of Team Nova Scotia will have about 430 members: 340 athletes, 76 coaches, managers and team staff, three artists and 16 mission staff.

Team Nova Scotia won 46 medals at the 2005 Canada Games in Regina, Saskatchewan. The team finished in sixth place overall, the same ranking as in 2001.

At 2001 Games in London, Team Nova Scotia won 47 medals and the Centennial Cup. Nova Scotia also won the Centennial Cup at the 1975 Winter Games in Lethbridge, Alberta, and at the 1981 Summer Games in Thunder Bay, Ontario. Nova Scotia also won the inaugural Claude Hardy Award in 2001, and again in 2003.

Nova Scotia has hosted the Games twice. The 1969 Summer Games were held in Halifax/Dartmouth, and the 1987 Winter Games were held in Sydney. The province will host the Games next in the winter of 2011.
